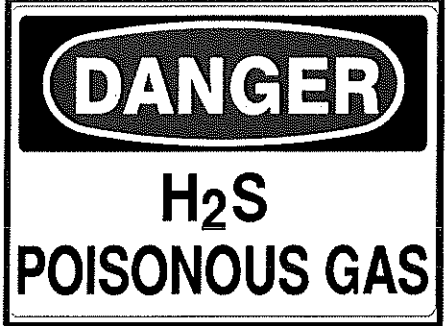

H2S ALIVE—ENFORM

The goal of H2S Alive is to prepare workers to recognize H2S hazards and protect themselves, as well as perform basic rescue during an H2S incident.

Hydrogen sulphide (H2S) is a highly toxic, colorless, combustible gas. It is heavier than air and has the unmistakable odor of rotten eggs.

This course begins with a comprehensive but simple presentation on H2S gas including its properties, exposure limits, health hazards and your initial response strategy.

Your training will also include an introduction to Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA). During this part of the course, you will learn how to do a pre-use inspection, how to operate the equipment and training in after-use inspection.

You will receive training in gas detection, which will require you to operate a manual gas detector and also gain an understanding of how electronic detectors work. Safety training with gas detection is very important.

There will be an opportunity to learn various techniques on how best to lift, drag, or carry a casualty to a safe area. This is a fun interactive training to use rescue techniques for your certification.

The last part of your certification will involve a 35 question quiz of which most are multiple choice. Upon successful completion of all required components of H2S training, you will earn an H2S Alive temporary training certificate. Your permanent card will be mailed to you by ENFORM in 4-6 weeks. This permanent ticket will be valid for three years.

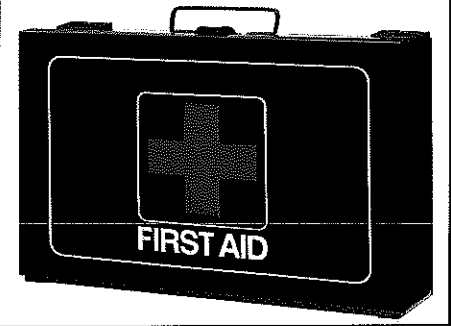

OCCUPATIONAL FIRST AID LEVEL 1

This hands-on 7 hour course teaches how to deal with the most common occupational first-aid emergencies.

Students will learn the Priority Action Approach to provide life saving first aid, enabling you to keep your co-worker or yourself alive until help arrives. Skills include primary survey, management of obstructed airway, management of absent breathing, CPR, use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), shock and bleeding management, as well as how to treat minor wounds. Also included, is how to identify the need for medical referral, providing follow-up care and be able to accurately complete the required First Aid Record.

No previous first aid training is required. Minimum age is 16 years old and photo ID is required.

Upon successful completion of this course, you will receive a certificate valid for three years.

This is a WorkSafe BC course and Kitimat Valley Institute is an authorized agency to deliver this training.

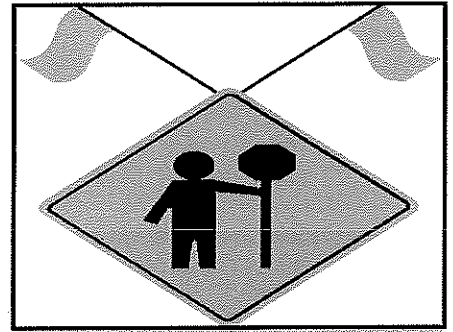

TRAFFIC CONTROL PERSON

The BCCSA's comprehensive, two-day standardized course for Traffic Control Persons (TCPs) consists of classroom and practical training and is the only program of its kind accepted by WorkSafe BC under Section 18 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations for high-risk traffic control. This two-day training session has been designed to qualify those who work as high-risk TCPs throughout the Province of BC.

Topics covered are:

- Roles & responsibilities of Traffic Control Person, employers and supervisors
- Regulations and standards, include those set out by Ministry of Transportation, WorkSafe BC and Motor Vehicle Act.
- Equipment and devices, including personal protective equipment
- Setting up, maintaining and removing work zones.
- Working around equipment
- Basic and advanced traffic control skills

Strictly Flagging are returning as the instructor for this engaging course.

Certification is valid for three years.

Basic Security Training

Security Professionals working in the province of British Columbia are required to complete mandatory training prior to being eligible for provincial licensing. You must be 19 years of age before you can apply for your Basic Security Training License.

Mandatory Basic Security Training is 40 hours in length, and focuses on the following content:

- Professionalism & Ethics
- Legal Studies
- Report Writing
- Personal Safety



Approved Security Training Schools are required to follow the training standards for the security industry as outlined in the Security Services Act.

Must be 19 years of age or older in order to apply to the Province of BC for security guard licensing.
