



# BASIC SECURITY TRAINING



Security professionals working in the province of British Columbia are required to complete mandatory training to qualify for provincial licensing. This course provides this basic training and covers key topics including: Introduction to Private Security, Legal Issues, Documentation and Personal Safety. The course entails approximately 25 hours of homework.

Participants must be 19 years of age to apply for their Basic Security Training License and complete a Criminal Records Check. Completion of Grade 10 and good reading skills are also prerequisites.
