Occupational First Aid Level 3

A 70-hour first aid course is designed for the rural or first aid attendant in heavy industry. This is a **WorkSafe BC** course.

Twenty lessons focus on obstructed airways, breathing distress, bleeding control, CPR and automated external defibrillator (AED). In addition, continuing patient assessment, hard collar application, securing a patient to a spine board, upper and lower limb splinting and minor wound care are covered. Completion of records and reports are an integral part of the course.

Written and practical exams are required after the course is complete. A minimum mark of 70% is required, on both written and practical exams. A 3-year certificate will be issued on successful completion.

Your registration form and payment needs to be made in advance to reserve your seat in the class. Course fees include textbooks and exams. Once registered and course fee is paid you can pick up the textbooks prior to the course start date. Home study, include pre-reading for each lesson and completion of homework is essential.

PREREQUISITES:

Must be at least 16 years of age and able to understand and perform first aid skills required to complete the learning tasks. No previous first aid training is required.

NOTE: *The course is physically demanding and can become rigorous. Knee pads are recommended.*
