Description:

This position will work under the direction of the project manager for the TNEI and in collaboration with the Director of Lands & Resources and will be responsible for tasks related to reclamation and environmental monitoring.

Site maintenance, including brushing and weeding is needed to facilitate successful growing conditions for seedlings and berries planted in the Tsimdimaas area (Hwy 16) in 2015. Bird nest surveys are required to identify active bird nests within or near sites being brushed so actions can be taken to reduce the risk of incidental destruction of nests.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Uses GPS and maps to hike through planted areas of cut blocks in order to identify and record location of active bird nests.
- Identifies bird species (if possible).
- Takes photos of birds and bird nests.
- Follows all applicable safety rules and procedures.
- Assists in other projects as required.

Skills and Qualifications:

- Ability to use GPS and maps preferred but not required.
- Ability to identify bird species preferred but not required.
- Ability to get along and work well with others.
- Employees will be required to use a camera and document species (if possible) and location of nests if found.
- Applicants need to be in good physical condition, willing and able to work long hours outdoors
- Employees will be required to wear steel toe boots on site.
